The NDSOC annual concourse will be broken into two different categories.

CONCOURSE D'ELEGANCE

SHOW AND SHINE

We need to explain the difference of these two categories so that you know where you want your car judged. Firstly there is the Concourse D'Elegance. Cars entered into this section should be cars that are considered STANDARD. That means as the car was delivered from the manufacturer's production line. In other words, a car that has never been painted, never had any of its components changed and is still in "MINT" condition, should in fact be a winning car.

Cars that have had restorations, changes, improvements and modifications, will have points deducted. In other words if you have an early Datsun which ran on points with a distributor and coil, and you have upgraded to electronic ignition, then you will have points deducted.

If you have replaced your coil, it should have been with a genuine Nissan coil for that model of Datsun. The rules will be based around the FIA rules for concourse judging.

The Show and Shine section will cover all other vehicles. This means that your car will be judged on its general appearance and its appeal to the judges. There will be awards for different categories of cars, such as best Roadster, best 240Z and so on.

What you need to make sure is that your car is clean presentable and that any modifications etc are of high quality. That your car is well looked after. What we are basically looking for is how your car is presented and maintained.

Points will be deducted from judged criteria and the cars with the highest points will be declared the winners. We will also try to have a "Peoples Choice" award as well.

It is a fairly broad spectrum from the Concourse to the Show and Shine category, so make sure you are aware of where your car really fits.
